## **Face-to-Face**

BigInfo spoke to Dr. Rajesh Singh, University Librarian, Delhi University, Delhi on a wide ranging professional and publishing issues. Some excerpts:



#### BI: Please share important landmarks in your professional journey.

**RS:** Having completed my studies at BHU, I started my professional journey in 1995 at Sainik School, Purulia and subsequently worked at ISM, Dhanbad, Rohilkhand University, Bareilly, RML Awadh University, Faizabad and finally in year 2006, I joined University of Delhi as Deputy Librarian. In 2020, I was appointed to the prestigious post of University Librarian of the University. Since then, it has been a very satisfying journey in terms of recognition and support. I had a distinct opportunity to be appointed, first as treasurer and subsequently, Chairman of the governing body of a University College for a period of 2 years in addition to my responsibilities as University Librarian. University also reposed trust in my abilities by making me member of a large number of committees. In 2024, University appointed me as Returning Officer for the election to Delhi University Student Union which is a huge honour for any University Librarian.

#### BI: Please share your vision for the Delhi University Library System.

**RS:** My vision for Delhi University Library, System and for Central Library particularly, is to scale it up to global standards and transform into a fully automated, secure, 24x7 learning resource centre, providing access to both its rich traditional print resources and modern e-resources. Work on the expansion of British era library building from existing 4000 to 12000 Sq. Meter space has already started. Library recently installed an RF based security system. Process of setting up an institutional repository for University publications, revival of digitisation projects and migrating LMS to Koha software is at an advanced stage. We recently added nearly 1.5 lakh eBooks to our huge resources of nearly 17 lakh print books and 47 electronic databases.

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As a member of "Digital Enablers "team of University, I am working on a single sign-on and facial authentication system for accessing e-resources from anywhere. We are working on research data visualisation, maximising research impact of our University by increased visibility of research output by leveraging social media platforms and increased number of information literacy programmes. to improve research metrics. We are also working on developing a platform for hosting a large number of journals being published by the university and its 90 constituent colleges. We intend to transform the central library into an academic common providing a scholarly and cultural space to our 4.5 lakh users.

# BI: Recently, DULS appointed 42 Library professionals at Assistant and Deputy Librarian post. What kind of skills and competencies have you been looking at in the selection process?

**RS:** We wanted a very dynamic team so as to provide leadership to the library system and focussed on the educational standards, ICT skills and a passion to serve. We have selected a judicious mix of teams, some having Computer Science and Engineering degrees in addition to MLIS from top universities and institutions like DRTC. They are being further trained through induction programmes by a team of experts.

#### BI: What are your views on the changing information landscape and role of electronic publishing?

**RS:** Publishing industry is an integral part of academia , providing a platform to research output. Publishers are partners in our teaching learning process. Publishers need to rework their pricing models so as to avoid the need for negotiating discounts, sometimes unbelievably high. Publishers further need to move to perpetual access models strongly as funds for renewal are decreasing. We look forward to collaborating with them on these common issues in coming years.




#### **EndNote Training & Certification Program**


